

ROUTE FROM THE BULL'S HEAD

Brown tourist signs direct you off the A512 Loughborough-Ashby road to the Bull's Head car park. Please park at the top end, furthest away from the pub. Follow the signs to the priory, which will take you along a path which goes under the old railway arch and turns left to go gently down hill. Just before the stream, you turn left and go under the huge railway viaduct.

To your left is a large disused quarry, which is a dangerous area to wander into. Where the path goes across the bed of the old canal, you turn right, through the gate and along the line of the canal until you reach another gate, which leads you into the priory grounds.
